

TEAM EXPECTATIONS

Students are committed for the entire season. (There is no refund if the student drops part way through)

- Parents Involvement

First LEGO League Teams (Ages 9-14)

- 1-2 competitions that are on the weekend. This depends on competition availability and if they advance.
- Teams will build and code an autonomous robot
- Teams will partake in a research project
- Teams will go through and interview and presentation during the competitions
- Teams meet 2 times per week.

VEX IQ (Ages 9-14)

- 2-3 Competitions that are on the weekend.
- Teams will build a robot. This team is about 95% mechanical build and 5% coding. The robot is mainly controlled via a remote control.
- Teams will keep an engineering notebook that will be presented at the competition.
- Teams meet 2 times per week.
